#### Mini-MOCK NW-1 TEACHING TRIAL

This trial is suitable for teams working on birch who are not yet ready to enter a "real" trial. As at a NW-1 trial, there will be 4 elements (interiors, exteriors, ~20 containers, & 3 vehicles) with one birch hide per element. However, search areas will be smaller and less complicated than at a NW-1 trial, and *unlike a NACSW trial*, you will be able to **watch other teams** once you have run your dog and you may have someone **video your run** – both are excellent learning opportunities.

#### \$30/team includes:

- \*water & snacks,
- \*judges' de-briefing at the end of the day, and
- \*one-on-one coaching from your judge if you get "stuck." If you miss a hide, the judge will coach you to the correct location so that your dog will always be successful.

Water will be available for your dogs but please bring your own bowl – for the health of your dog and on the recommendation of our veterinarian, no communal water bowls will be provided.

Please do NOT handle odor on the day of the trial.
