

# WELCOME TO TRUSTLAND TRAILS

## Directions:

From SR525 traveling south, turn right onto Craw Road. If traveling north on SR525, turn left onto Craw Road. Follow Craw Road to the trail entrance on the right-hand side.

Especially designed for accessibility, families of all abilities will enjoy this woodland paradise and the hard surface ADA trail accessible from the parking lot. Also, for the sport enthusiast or fitness buff, the 1.5 mile existing trail is a good warm-up for a longer run or bicycle ride. Horse riders will be well suited to use the Multi-Use Trail for a beautiful ride through Pacific NW flora and fauna.
