# Go Outside and Play

## General Information

**DETAILS** More detailed information will be emailed to registered participants prior to start of program.

**EQUIPMENT** For safety we highly recommend all participants wear helmets. Each participant must have up-to-date equipment which have been adjusted to fit the Snowrider's boots. Equipment must be in good working condition and checked by a ski shop tech. Need gear? Check out Grass Roots Outdoor's ad on the back of this brochure for gear and rentals.

**MOUNTAIN INFO** For Stevens Pass information, call them at 206-812-4510 or [www.stevenspass.com](http://www.stevenspass.com). For Mt. Baker information, call them at 360-734-6771 or visit [www.mtbaker.us](http://www.mtbaker.us).

**REFUNDS** The last day to guarantee a refund is December 16th. However, if a participant is injured we do refund the registration fee on a pro-rated basis, contingent on a physician's recommendation. There will be no make up lessons or refunds for classes missed by a student. A \$30 service fee will be charged for all participant initiated refunds and credits. In the event that the SnowRider bus is cancelled, no refunds will be given on purchases toward lift tickets or season passes.

**CANCELLATIONS** As we cannot control the weather, we cannot guarantee 8 consecutive weeks. A trip may be cancelled due to weather conditions or if pass is closed. We do guarantee to provide services within the normal ski season (Jan.-Mar.) or return unused portion of fee. SWPRD will reschedule any cancelled trips at the first available date. Refunds are only for trips that are cancelled by SWPRD and not rescheduled.

**ONE-TIME RIDERS** Space can be very limited on the bus. Our first priority is to provide seats to the riders who have enrolled for the season. If space allows, we will make a few seats available to "One Time Riders" for \$45 plus tax. Youth signing up for one time must be at least 13 and experienced on the mountain. Registration & payment is required 3 days prior. Information on availability will be posted after December 15.

## Youth Bus 8 Saturdays at Stevens Pass

**SCHEDULE** **Saturdays, January 7 - February 25.** Bus departs Coupeville at 5:20 am, bus departs Clinton at 6:10 am. Bus will depart mountain at 4:30 pm and arrive in Clinton at approximately 6:50 pm and Coupeville at approximately 7:40 pm. We will provide a Mukilteo pick-up if there's interest.

**PARTICIPATION** Participants must be ages 10 -18 to participate in this program, must be self sufficient, able to care for themselves throughout the day, able to carry their own gear, and be ON TIME to the bus. We recommend that younger kids sign up with a friend. Lessons are mandatory for 10-12 year olds and beginners.

**LESSONS** Clancy's program is **6 weeks** of lessons (ending Feb. 11) , and are available for every ability. Clancy's offers great classes to keep kids challenged and interested in learning. Lessons are two hours, 10 am-12 noon or 1 pm-3 pm. Full day lessons are available for an extra charge. Lessons mandatory for ages 10-12 and beginners.

**LIFT TICKETS** Participants can buy discount lift tickets each week on the bus. Participants must pay by check, payable to STEVENS PASS to receive discount tickets. ***Lift Ticket Rates:***

- Stevens Lift Ticket (Ages 7 - 12) ..... \$35/day includes tax (\$7 discount!)
- Stevens Lift Ticket (Ages 13 - 15) ..... \$45/day includes tax (\$7 discount!)
- Stevens Lift Ticket (Ages 16+) ..... \$55/day includes tax (\$7 discount!)

## Adult Bus 8 Thursdays at Stevens Pass & Mt. Baker

**SCHEDULE** **Thursdays, January 12 - March 1.** Bus departs Oak Harbor 5:15, Coupeville 5:45 am, bus departs Clinton 6:30 am, bus departs Everett, 7:40 am. Bus leaves the mountain at 3:30 pm. We attempt to catch the 6:00 pm ferry. The Mt. Baker trip is Feb. 23rd and will have a different pick-up/drop-off schedule, TBA.
