TO BRING

- A JOURNAL, of course. I will have 3 or 4 different forms for sale if you do not make it to a University bookstore (cheapest place to buy, good variety). Look for a nice drawing surface, preferably without lines. Everybody is different, but I recommend the big black art notebooks 9 X 11" available in art stores for about \$16, or the half size of that, about \$9. Choose one that fits your character. A journal in progress is good.
- A black pen or pencil to draw with (my favorite are the Pilot Varsity pens, disposable fountain pens with black ink. The Rolling Ball Pilot V pens have real ink and are nice for writing and art. Bic and ball points are out: they have gummy, fake ink.
- Any art supplies you already have which are appropriate for journal (won't rub off with wear)
- Several big sheets of practice or scratch paper, such as shelf paper or news print or even brown paper bags opened up. For gestures.
- A soft crayon, pastel, conte or charcoal with which to do gesture drawings.
